

CONTRAINDICATIONS

Lymphatic Therapy Treatments

Specific (relates directly to Prins Lymphatic Therapy treatments)

Local skin or soft-tissue condition.

Extremely reactive or fragile skin, recent skin surgery on and around the area.

Allergies.

Please familiarise yourself with the ingredients list and complete a thorough consultation prior to minimise the risk of any adverse reactions.

General (relates to manual Lymphatic Drainage)

Caution

- Thyroid Dysfunction
- Bronchial Asthma
- Hypotension
- Diabetes
- Edema following carcinoma treatment
- Edema caused by cardiac decompensation should not be drained manually, as this may exacerbate such decompensation
- High blood pressure, rheumatism, asthma, lupus, cancer, arthritis, and thrombosis or thyroid problems

Absolute Contraindications <Doctors Clearance Required>

- Those who have had numerous lymph nodes removed as it can increase the risk of lymphedema
- Any thrombosis at risk of causing embolism is an absolute contraindication
- Any metastatic or systemic malignant condition
